

### Guide for Pre- Physical Therapy Advising:

While most pre-physical therapy students will pursue a Kinesiology major, major-prep for Kinesiology often *does not* include all DPT prerequisites. So, students may want to consider adding additional courses to their education plan to meet both transfer and DPT prerequisites.

So, students will need:

1. GE
2. Major prep
3. Additional DPT prep depending on target program/s (at either MCC or transfer school)
